

## PIDDINGTON ROMAN VILLA EXCAVATION HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

- It is the duty of all personnel, under the Health & Safety at Work Act 1974, to take reasonable care for the health and safety of him /herself and other persons who may be affected by their actions.

    - Appropriate clothing, footwear, personal protective equipment (ppe);
  - Responsible use of tools and equipment;
  - Compliance with the Society's 'zero tolerance' of possession or use of illegal substances.
